The Week following the 20th Sunday after Trinity (October 25-31, 2020)

Daylight Saving Ends this Sunday- November 1st !

We all get an extra hour of sleep this coming weekend, provided you remember to turn BACK your clock.

No Zoom service at 10am this Sunday- Nov 1st

As noted below- we will Zoom the live and in-person outdoor **11am** outdoor service this coming Sunday. If you are a "Zoomer" join us at 11am!

November 1- **11am** All Saints Day- at the Turner Ranch- in person AND by Zoom

We will celebrate **live and in-person**, the Eucharist this Sunday at our monthly OUTDOOR service and self-catered picnic at the Turner Ranch- 18 Esquiline Drive, Carmel Valley. The service will also be Zoomed!

The **service begins at 11am** (Pacific Standard time). Mary Clare will bring her field organ to provide music AND we will also be serenaded by Harp and Cello from the porch! Remember to bring your own food and beverage for the picnic that follows the service!

Directions to the Turner Ranch

1. Get on Highway One -southbound toward Carmel Valley
2. In about 4 miles get in left turn lane to turn onto Carmel Valley Road. Head east on Carmel Valley Road
3. Stay on Carmel Valley road for about 12 miles. You will come to Carmel Valley Village. Drive thru the Village. As you near the east end of the Village look for Esquiline Road on your right. Turn right onto Esquiline Road.
4. The road goes downhill. In less than 1/2 mile you will approach a bridge (that crosses the Carmel River) **DON'T CROSS THE BRIDGE !**

5. Just before the bridge there is a gravel road on the left- that is the entrance to the Turner Ranch -18 Esquiline Road.

6. Drive down the neatly manicured gravel road and avoid the suicidal deer and if possible, the mountain lions. Parking is available near the lodge. Extra parking is available by the giraffe.

St. John's is officially on the National Register of Historic Places

We received word from the federal government that St. John's Chapel has been placed on the National Register of Historic Places effective October 21, 2020. Thank you Dick and Elizabeth Barratt for guiding St. John's through the entire process from start to successful finish. Well Done!
