# Collect and Lessons for Christmas Day- 2020

#### The Collect

ALMIGHTY God, who hast given us thy only begotten Son to take our nature upon him, and as at this time to be born of a pure virgin; Grant that we being regenerate, and made thy children by adoption and grace, may daily be renewed by thy Holy Spirit; through the same our Lord Jesus Christ, who liveth and reigneth with thee and the same Spirit ever, one God, world without end. *Amen*.

#### The Old Testament Lesson

The Old Testament Lesson is written in the 5<sup>th</sup> Chapter of the Book of the Prophet Micah beginning at the 2<sup>nd</sup> verse:

<sup>2</sup> But you, O Bethlehem Ephrathah, who are too little to be among the clans of Judah, from you shall come forth for me one who is to be ruler in Israel, whose origin is from of old, from ancient days.

<sup>4</sup> And he shall stand and shepherd his flock in the strength of the LORD, in the majesty of the name of the LORD his God. And they shall dwell secure, for now he shall be great to the ends of the earth. <sup>5</sup> And he shall be their peace. Here endeth the Old Testament Lesson.

#### Psalm 96. Cantate Domino.

We will read Psalm 96 responsively by the whole verse:

1 Sing unto the LORD a new song; \* sing unto the LORD, all the whole earth.

- 2 Sing unto the LORD, and praise his Name; \* be telling of his salvation from day to day.
- 3 Declare his honour unto the heathen, \* and his wonders unto all peoples.
- 4 For the LORD is great, and cannot worthily be praised;\* he is more to be feared than all gods.
- 5 As for all the gods of the heathen, they are but idols; \* but it is the LORD that made the heavens.
- 6 Glory and worship are before him; \* power and honour are in his sanctuary.
- 7 Ascribe unto the LORD, O ye kindreds of the peoples, \* ascribe unto the LORD worship and power.
- 8 Ascribe unto the LORD the honour due unto his Name; \* bring presents, and come into his courts.
- 9 O worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness; \* let the whole earth stand in awe of him.
- 10 Tell it out among the heathen, that the LORD is King, and that it is he who hath made the round world so fast that it cannot be moved; \* and how that he shall judge the peoples righteously.
- 11 Let the heavens rejoice, and let the earth be glad; \* let the sea make a noise, and all that therein is.

# 12 Let the field be joyful, and all that is in it; \* then shall all the trees of the wood rejoice before the LORD.

13 For he cometh, for he cometh to judge the earth; \* and with righteousness to judge the world, and the peoples with his truth.

Glory be the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Ghost; As it was in the beginning is now and ever shall be, world without end, Amen.

## The New Testament Lesson

The New Testament Lesson is written in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Chapter of Titus beginning at the 4<sup>th</sup> verse:

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>4</sup>But when the kindness and love of God our Savior appeared, <sup>5</sup>he saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, <sup>6</sup> whom he poured out on us generously through Jesus Christ our Savior, <sup>7</sup> so that, having been justified by his grace, we might become heirs having the hope of eternal life.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>8</sup> This is a trustworthy saying. And I want you to stress these things, so that those who have trusted in God may be careful to devote themselves to doing what is good. These things are excellent and profitable for everyone.

## The Holy Gospel

The Holy Gospel is written in the 1<sup>st</sup> Chapter of John beginning at the 1<sup>st</sup> verse: **Glory be to thee, O Lord** 

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. <sup>2</sup> The same was in the beginning with God. <sup>3</sup> All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made. <sup>4</sup> In him was life; and the life was the light of men. <sup>5</sup> And the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not.

<sup>6</sup> There was a man sent from God, whose name was John. The same came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all men through him might believe. <sup>8</sup> He was not that Light, but was sent to bear witness of that Light.

<sup>9</sup> That was the true Light, which lighteth every man that cometh into the world. <sup>10</sup> He was in the world, and the world was made by him, and the world knew him not. <sup>11</sup> He came unto his own, and his own received him not.

<sup>12</sup> But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name: <sup>13</sup> Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

<sup>14</sup> And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.
